209 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Vardry M'Be of the Town of Lincolnton in the state of north Carolina for & in the consideration of the sum of one thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by Moses Parris of Greenville district and state aforesaid have this day bargained sold & released & do by these presents sell & release unto the said Moses Parris a certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred acres lying & being in the said district of Greenville on both sides of the south fork of Cushey creek of Ruddy River beginning at a red oak thence south 20^o E 38 chs to a post oak thence S. 70^o W 18 chs to a post oak thence S. 20^o E 20 chs. to a red oak thence N. 70^o E 55 chs. to a red oak thence N. 30^o W 59 chs. to a stake thence S. 70^o W 26 chs. to the beginning being a tract of land originally granted to Matthew Lowry bearing date 18th day of January 1785 together with all & singular the rights privileges & appurtenances to all or any part of them or all on banks that may hereafter be found on the said premises with the entire free privilege of digging hauling away and making use of the sand the said Vardry M'Be reserves the entire rights thereof to himself or to his heirs or assigns with the privilege aforesaid hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Moses Parris his heirs & assigns forever I do bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and for ever
