ning John Nashes line to Edward Nashes line thence on
said line to Black oak corner and thence with said
Nashes line to the Beginning corner together with all and
Singular the rights members Hereditaments and Appurtenan-
ces to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
thereto to have & to hold all and singular the Premises be-
fore mentioned unto the s^d Edward Nash his heirs and assigns
for ever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and
Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and sin-
gular the premises before mentioned unto the said Edward
Nash his heirs and assigns against my self & my my heirs
and no further lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof. witness my hand & seal this twenty second
day of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and
twenty & in the forty fifth year of the independence of the United
