George Salmon of Greenville District and state aforesaid In consideration of one Hundred and seven Dollars to me in hand well & truly paid by William Lynch son of John of the district aforesaid the receipt whereof I do here acknowledge have Granted Bargained sold released, conveyed and Confirmed and by these presents do grant Bargain sell release convey and Confirm unto the said William Lynch his heirs ^{a certain} and assigns ^{that place} a parcel of Land whereon James Callaway now lives containing fifty acres be the the same more less situate in Greenville District aforesaid on a Branch of the Panther fork of Blush Creek and Branches of the North fork of Saluda River & runs as follows Beginning on a stake on the west line of a lot of Land Belonging to the heirs of James Rodden thence south twenty five degrees west to a large Spanish oak said Roddens corner thence west to large Hickory thence North twenty five degrees East a Spanish oak of my original line thence to the Beginning together with all and singular the right manors heirs Hereditaments & appertainances to the said premises belonging and in any wise Incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said William Lynch his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular the premises above mentioned to the said William Lynch his heirs & assigns against my self my heirs Executors & administrators & against all & every other person & persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
