The State of South Carolina To all whom these presents shall come,  
I Thomas Payne of the district Greenville and state aforesaid  
send greeting, Whereas I Thomas Payne by two promissory notes of  
hand bearing date the twenty seventh of November anno Domini one  
thousand eight hundred and twenty, I have made, to William Toney  
of the State and district aforesaid in the sum of Six hundred and sixteen  
dollars & 13/100 payable to said Toney on the thirteenth day of the  
present month, November, and one other note given by me to said  
William Toney and made by said Toney to David Teary for the  
purpose of obtaining a loan for the use of said Payne drawn payable  
to said Toney three days after date, made on the twenty seventh  
day of this month November aforesaid, for the sum of one hundred  
and sixty five dollars. Now know all men by these presents that  
that I the said Thomas Payne for and consideration of the  
sets or sums aforesaid of seven hundred and eighty one dollars 13/100  
and for better securing the payment thereof to the said William  
Toney his heirs or assigns, Have granted bargained sold & released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell<sup>to</sup> unto the said  
William Toney all that plantation or tract of land containing  
eighty five and one third acres, and one other tract containing forty  
acres (more or less) being being the place whereof I now live which  
I bought of James Tarrant Situate in the district aforesaid on  
the Golam Grove creek it being part of a tract of land originally  
granted to John Bowe and hath such lines borders and bounda-  
ries as is laid down by a deed from said James Tarrant to the  
said Thomas Payne, Together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments & appertaining to the said premises belo-  
nging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and to  
Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
said William Toney his heirs and assigns forever. and I further  
by this my self my heirs Executors and administrators towards  
and forever aforesaid all and singular the said premises unto  
the said William Toney his heirs & assigns against myself &  
my heirs and against all and every other person or persons lawf-  
ully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.  
Provided always nevertheless. and it is the true intent and me-  
aning of the parties to these presents that if the said Tho. Payne  
his Heirs Executors or administrators shall will & truly pay or cause to be  
paid to the said William Toney his certain attorney heirs Executors  
administrators & assigns the said sum or sums of money in the said  
notes mentioned together with all it interest or damages that may  
arise thereon according to the tenor and effect of the said notes  
then this Deed of Mortgage and every clause & article therein shall  
be utterly null and void, any thing herein contained to the
