these presents that we George Tuckersley & Elizabeth Tuckersley of the State
and district aforesaid in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and
forty four dollars & fifty cents to me paid by John Wilkinson of the State
and district aforesaid, Have granted, bargained, sold and released by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John
Wilkinson a plantation and part of a tract of land originally
granted to Richard Wood for 640 acres about the year 1784
laying in the state and district aforesaid on the waters of the

Golden iron creek, including the house & plantation where the
said Wilkinson now lies with two hundred & sixty seven and
a half acres of land (by the same more or less.) Beginning on
a rock on the mill branch near the poor road thence running
N 45 E 25° 21' to a hickory thence N 45 E 18° 78' to a chestnut thence
N 45 E 19° 80' to a stake thence N 45 E 36° 40' to a red oak (dead)
thence N 45 W 61' to a rock on the said mill branch thence down
the meander of said branch to the beginning. Together with
all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments to the
said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
ing. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said John Wilkinson his heirs & assigns
