granted to Edward Howard bearing date one thousand seven hundred & ninety
five and recorded in grant book O, N: 3 page 179 the land conveyed begin-
ing on a black Jack 37 thence N. 80 E 38 to a Spanish Oak 37 thence S 12
E 3 to a Post oak, thence S 50 E 15 to a Post oak 37 thence S 70 W 20.50 to a Red
Oak, thence N. 63 W. 34.50 to a pine 37 thence N. 37 links to the beginning, to
include fifty two acres. Together with all and singular therights, mem-
bers hereditaments there unto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
