

Deed dated the 21st day of November 1816 will fully appear, also 278
one other tract of land lying in said district on Cedy river at the
place generally known as the Fork Shoal, containing by estima-
tion one hundred and thirty acres more or less beginning on Cedy
river on the line of the late Mr. Peden, thence on the same to a
red oak 3⁺ near the S. Smiths fence thence on same to a post oak
3⁺ lately made near S. Peden's fence thence N. W. 7^o by a new line
thence by Baker's line to Cedy river & down the same with the
meandy to the beginning. To have & to hold the S. tract of land
as described to the said James his heirs or assigns forever & I do hereby
bind myself my heirs &c. to warrant & defend the same, unto
the said James & his, against myself & mine and against all
manner of Claims whatsoever either of law or of any other
kind in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
this 23rd day of Aug. 1819. Testes
