the increase of the females, also a boy he bought of the Sheriff
named Moses. - Item 5th To my Son Jeremiah Stokes I give & bequeath
ten dollars in Cash - Item 6th To my Son John Stokes I give and
bequeath ten dollars in Cash. - Item 7th To my Daughter
Jery Green I give & bequeath ten dollars in Cash. - Item 8th To
my Daughter Rachel Towny I give & bequeath ten dollar Cash
Item 9th To my Daughter Elizabeth Paul I give & bequeath ten
dollar Cash. - Item 10th To my Son Hugh Stokes I give and
bequeath (at the death of my said wife) all my household
& kitchen furniture, Plantation tools of every description &
debts then due - Item 11th At the death of my said wife all
the rest & residue of my Estate not herein before particularly
disposed of such as Stock of Horses, Cattle, hogs, &c &c after pay-
-ing my debts & funeral expences & the Legacies before mentioned
to be equally divided between my sons Levi & Hughes. -
Item 12th I give & bequeath to my Son Hugh Stokes all my
land where I now live which Lays on the East Side of
Uddy River & to my Son Levi I give & bequeath all my land
which Lays on the West Side of Said River adjoining where
I now live. - Lastly I do hereby nominate ~~constitute~~ & appoint
my Sons Jonathan & Jeremiah Executors to this my last will
& Testament hereby revoking & annulling every other former
will by me made, and publishing & pronouncing this to be
my last will and Testament. Given under my hand &
