Know all men by these presents that I  
John McBlanahan of the district of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid for and in consideration  
of a negro woman named Helly to me sold and  
and delivered by Thomas G Walker of the District  
and State aforesaid have granted bargained  
sold released and conveyed and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell release and convey unto  
the said Thomas G Walker his heirs and assigns  
all that plantation tract or parcel of Land  
on which I now live situated in the district aforesaid  
on the waters of Rudy River being composed of  
two tracts or parcels; one conveyed to me by Joseph  
Bridges of one hundred and nine acres; being  
part of a tract granted to Thomas Locke of  
two hundred and Eighteen acres having such  
shape marks boundaries and boundaries as are  
represented in the plat to the original grant  
annexed, and in the deed of conveyance from  
Joseph Bridges to me as by reference thereto  
more fully appear; the other part or tract con-  
veyed to trustees for my use behoof and benefit  
by Solomon Langston on the second day of Novem-  
ber 1809 and therein particularly described  
as a reference thereto will show and containing  
according to the said deed forty four acres; the  
whole containing by estimation one hundred and  
Forty acres more or less to gether with all and  
the rights members hereditaments and appurten-  
ances thereto be lawfully in any wise in  
account or appurtenance; to have and to hold  
all and singular the premises a bove
