John Bates one tract or lot of land situate lying in the  
District of Greenville and State aforeso on the waters  
of the North fork of Saluda River bounded as follows  
To wit beginning at the forks of the branch that  
Runs in to the branch call'd the mile branch, thence  
Running up the branch that heads near the Widow gills  
old fields bounded on lands belonging to John & William  
Bates containing fifty acres more or less it being  
Part of tract of land that was original Granted to  
John Book on the sixth day of Feber 1786 Conveyd  
By Sc Butt to Bayless Earle to John Bates Junr conveyd  
From John Bates senr to William Bates together with  
all & singular the rights, members hereditaments and  
appertinences to the sd premises belonging or in any  
wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned  
The sd John Bates junr his heirs Executors Administrators  
For ever & I do hear by bind my self my Heirs  
Executors and Administrators to warrant & defend  
All and singular the premises unto the sd John Bates  
His Heirs & assigns a gainst my self & my Heirs a gainst  
Every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof  
I have unto set my hand & seal this 15 sept in the year of  
our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & twenty one & in  
the forty fifth of the independence of the united States of A  
merica signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
