Greenville District presents that George
Bradley of the Dist aforesaid for and in consideration
of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me in hand
Paid by Thos Hooper of the District aforesaid
who have granted Bargained and sold unto
the said Thomas Hooper a certain tract or
Parcel of land containing fifty acres be the
same more or less Beginning on a stump corner
on Esli Hunt's line thence near an East corner
to a conditional line made between George
Bradley and the said Thos Hooper thence with
the conditional line to the S. Hooper's original
line thence down to line to a red oak corner
to the beginning corner together with all and singular
the rights, members, hereditaments and appertainments
to the above premises belonging or in any wise -
appertaining to have and to hold all & singular
the premises before mentioned unto the sd Thos.
Hooper and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
Administrators and assigns to warrant & forever
defend the above mentioned premises from myself
my heirs and from every other person or persons
who or whosoever claiming or to claim the same or
any part thereof to the said Thos Hooper his heirs
or assigns for ever in witness whereof I here
un to set my hand & seal this 24th day of
January 1822 signed sealed & delivered in presence
of Esli Hunt George Bradley
