my hand and seal this 6 day of June AD 1797

Before me Henry Gray one of the Justices of the peace personally came William Turpin Junr. who being qualified according to Law affirms that he saw Thomas Wadsworth sign Seal and as his act and deed deliver this deed for the uses & purposes within mentioned and that he together with James Boyle signed their names as witnesses to the due Execution of the same Charleston April 27 - 1809
