at a white oak tree southwardly to a Spanish
oak & thence south eastwardly to a Spanish oak then
north eastwardly to pine corner thence a long
said line to the River then up the beginning
corner to have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said James
Calhoun his heirs or assigns and I do here by bind
my self my heirs Executors administrators to warrant
and forever defend the before mentioned premises
unto the said James Calhoun & I do hereby
