of North Carolina for & in consideration of the  
sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to me  
in hand paid by Richard Thurston of Greenville  
District in the said State of South Carolina have  
granted bargained sold & released and by these  
presents doth grant bargain sell & release unto  
the said Richard Thurston two certain Lots of  
land situate lying and being in the village  
at Greenville Court House known & distinguished  
in the Plan of the said Village as laid out by  
Vary No 14 & 16 in in the North West Square of  
said Village bounded as follows viz No 14 beginning  
Stake corner no. 12 in the same Square running  
thence north 16 degrees East 113 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet on Lawrence  
Street to a corner of Lot no 16 thence on the  
division line of the said lots no. 14 & 16 north  
74 west two hundred feet to a Stake thence  
south 16 West 113 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to a Stake corner of no 12  
as a fore said thence to the Beginning also the said  
lot no 16 Beginning on a Stake corner of the said  
lots here by conveyed & runs no. 16 East 113 $\frac{1}{2}$   
feet a long Lawrence Street to a Stake on Wash-  
ington Street thence no. 74 west 200 feet a long  
Washington Street to a Stake thence so. 16
