contain thirty three acres be the same more or less
situate in Greenville District a fore said at the head
of a branch of Soil fork of Clear creek of South
Tyger River, beginning on a persimmon on said
branch & running So. E. to Bensons old line thence
S 60 W. to a black oak on the south side of the bus-
-comb Road thence to the head of said
Edwards Spring Branch thence down the
Branch to the beginning, Together with all and
singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or
in any wise incident or appertaining to have
and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Joseph Edwards his
heirs and assigns forever & I do hereby bind
my self my heirs Executors administrators to war-
-rant and for ever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Joseph Edwards
his heirs and assigns against my self & my
heirs & against every other person whomsoever
