to a rock 3+ at its confluence of a larger branch  
thence down the meanders of said branch to the be-  
gining. it being the tract of land occupied by  
me aforesaid Jacob Nabours Deceased) Together  
with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
