


182, by Patton bearing date the first day of April  
 1793 and recorded in the Grant Book G. N. 5  
 page 149 beginning on a white oak corner on the  
 original line on the bank of said Rocky creek and  
 runs due north on said line 7.50 to red oak 3+ from  
 thence S 82 W. 14. 10 to a stake corner thence S 40 W. 33. 90. to stake  
 corner thence S 30 E. on the original line where said line  
 crosses the said Long branch near a gum station thence  
 down the meanders of said branch to a water oak  
 corner at the mouth of said branch thence the meanders  
 of Rocky creek to the beginning white oak corner which  
 includes all the land to be conveyed by the same mov  
 or left. Together with all and singular the rights, members  
 Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belon  
 -ing or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and  
 to hold all and singular the premises be fore mentioned  
 unto the said William Harbin his heirs and assigns forever  
 and I do hereby bind my self my Executors and admin  
 -istrators to warrant and forever defend all and singu  
 -lar the said Premises unto the said William Harbin  
 his heirs and assigns against my self and my  
 heirs. and against every person whomsoever lawfully  
 Claiming or to Claim the same or any part thereof  
 Witness my hand and seal this twenty 3 day of November  
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight and  
 in the twenty third year of the Independence of  
 the united States of America.
