South Carolina. To all to whom these presents shall come
I Thomas Payne Sheriff of Grunville District and State
aforesaid, send Greeting; where as by virtue of an order issued
out of the Court of Common Pleas held for said district
tested the second day of November in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and fifteen at the suit
of Robert Alexander one of the heirs of James Seabourn
Deceased, against Mary Seabourn the widow by a writ
of partition which order directed that I should on the first
Monday in January then next ensuing after having given
lawful notice there of proceed to sell the lands of James
Seabourn deceased agreeable to the Return of the commissioners
in convenient tract, lots or Plantations, upon, a credit of
twelve months, and that the money arising from
said sales be divided between the parties entitled pursuant
to the directions of the act of Assembly in obedience to the said
order. There are seized and taken of the lands of the said
James Seabourn a tract of three hundred and eleven acres
more or less distinguished as lot no. 16 situate in Grunville District
on both sides of Stony Creek waters of Ruddy River, beginning
at on a Black oak running thence \$ 54 E. 80 to a
