Know all men by these presents, that J. Rowland Clarke  
of the District of Grunville and State aforesaid for and in  
consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in  
hand paid by Wiley Sanders of the same place the receipt  
whereof is here by acknowledged, have granted, bargained  
sold, released and conveyed and by these presents do grant  
bargain, sell, release and convey unto the said Wiley Sanders  
all that certain tract of land situate lying and being in  
the district of Grunville and State aforesaid, on the north for  
N. of Vaughns Creek of North Pacolet River being the same  
tract that was granted to Henry Clarke by grant dated  
the fourth day of February Anno Domini one thousand  
seven hundred and ninety three by William Moultrie  
Esquire Governor and commander in chief in and over the  
said State, and surveyed for the said Henry Clarke by W.  
D. Thomas Deputy Survr the 20 of October 1792, and conveyed  
to the said Robert Clarke by Edward Ward by deed  
bearing date the fifteenth day of October in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and three, containing  
one hundred and thirty four acres more or less, beginning  
at a red oak and runs thence S. 60 E. 18 Chaines to a Stake  
thence S. 35 Chaines to a Stake thence N 61 W. 50 Chaines to  
a Stake thence N. 20 W. 23 Chaines to a Stake thence S. 86  
E. 35 Chaines and 50 links to the beginning red oak
