to a Stake on the bank of the Creek thence
up the meanders of the Creek to to the beginning
Which land I do warrant and defend unto
the said Thompson from me and my heirs Ex-
Admrs. or assigns and all other persons claiming
the same or any part thereof for ever and
and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Ex-
Admrs. or assigns and forever defend all &
singular the premises, a bove mentioned unto
said Thompson a gainst my self my heirs
Ex-Admrs. or assigns all and every other person
or persons lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof As witness
I have set my hand and seal this the twenty
fourth day of April one thousand eight hundred
