

William Brown, as his act and deed for the use
and purpose within mentioned and that
Peter Shockley, was a subscribing witness with
him to the same sworn to and subscribed before
me this the nineteenth day of October 1819.

certify unto all whom it may concern that Sary
Pike the wife of Henry Pike did this day appear
before me and upon being privately and
separately Examined by me did declare that
she dose truly voluntarily and without any
compulsion dread or fear of any person
or persons whomsoever Renounce Release
and forever relinquish unto William Brown
his heirs and assigns, all her interest and estate
in a certain tract or parcel of Land lying
on brushy creek of Enore River, containing
Ninety five acres sold by Henry Pike,
to William Brown given under my
hand and seal this the nineteenth
day of October 1819. Sary ^{her} Pike
