Together with all and singular Hereditaments and appertinances to the premises, belonging, or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Dill his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises unto the said John Dill his heirs and assigns for ever against my self my heirs and against all and every other person lawfully Claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in Witness whereof I said William Charstain have hereunto set my hand and seal affixed my seal this nineteenth day January one thousand eight hundred and twenty In presence of
