Maultre the 4 of July 1785. beginning on the  
Fox branch on an a good line between Soak  
Bruton & said Robert Benson, from thence  
with said original line to a white oak thence  
N. 88 W. 26. 10 to a Red oak thence No. 26 to  
a pine thence no. 40 W. 3. to a stake thence  
no. 25. E 33 to a Hickey thence 46. E. with front  
line to said creek thence down the meanders  
of said creek to the mouth of Fox branch  
from thence up said branch to the begin-  
ning the number of acres unknown  
we the said William B. Benson &  
Thornton Benson will warrant
