Know all men by these Presents that Whereas Henry Prince Senior on the Fifteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Fourteen by his deed in writing under his hand Seal duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of Greenville District in Book I. pages 322 & 323. the first of November 1814 did give grant and convey unto Thomas Prince and Henry Prince Junr. jointly a certain Plantation Tract a parcel of Land whereon the said Henry then lived on both sides of South Tiger river in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid, containing Four hundred and ninety eight acres, Bounded as by reference to the said deed may appear. Now know ye that I the said Thomas Prince in order to make division and Partition of the said tract of Land between myself and the said Henry Prince Junr. and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by the said Henry Prince Junr. Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry Prince Junior, all my right title interest Claim and demand whatsoever of in or to all and singular that part of the tract of Land above mentioned which lays on the North or north East Side of the said Tiger River and which with its meanders of the River the line between us supposed to contain four hundred acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to Have and to hold all and singular the said part of the tract above mentioned unto the said Henry Prince for his heirs assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and defend the said premises unto the said Henry Prince for his heirs and assigns against myself any my heirs Claiming or to claim the same or any part
