on both sides of the North Fork of Saluda River.  
Also one other parcel of land joining the a bove men-  
tioned tract containing by estimation thirty five acres  
being part of a tract of land granted to John  
Clayton the fifteenth day of October one thousand  
seven hundred and eighty four, also one other  
parcel of land joining both of the above described  
tracts containing by estimation forty five more or  
less being part of a tract of seventy six acres of  
land granted to John Mottow the second day  
of October one thousand seven hundred and eight  
ty six making in the whole added together four  
hundred and thirty acres be the same more or  
less and runs as follows, agreeable to the courses  
and distances on the Plats annexed to the original  
grants and the conditional lines beginning  
on a maple at the mouth of a branch in the  
first tract mentioned in this deed then to  
up the said branch and a ditch to a white  
Oak corner the bank of the ditch thence south  
thirty eight degrees west five chains and fifty  
links to a stake thence south fourteen degrees  
west five chains and seventy five links to a  
white Oak thence south twenty nine degrees west  
to a Stake on the original line of said tract of land  
thence North eighty two degrees East fifty eight cha-  
ins fifty links to a post oak thence north eighty  
degrees west fifty eight chains to a stake on Sprig  
line thence south eighty two degrees west twenty  
two chains and fifty links to a stake on the west  
side of the river then up the meanders of the said  
River to the mouth of the Crane field branch

East with Clayton's line to red oak Mottow's
