


310. The receipt is hereby acknowledged have granted
bargained and sold and by these presents do.
grant bargain and sell unto Matthew Carter—
fifty Acres of land out of a tract of two hundred
acres granted Zachariah Blackwell for him at law
to Daniel Blackwell per bearing date the first day of
August one thousand seven hundred and
Eighty five granted by his Excellency William Blount
Governor for the time being which land was con-
veyed from said Blackwell to John Tulee from
to Benjamin Benson from him to Thos Benson from
to Moses Bates, which will more fully appear by the
Record which land being and lying in the District
and State aforesaid on the head waters of Enore
River and bounded as follows. beginning on a
red oak a corner of Bates and Blackwells land
Running thence N. 62. E. to a gum on the bank of
a large branch thence up the several meanders
of sd. branch to John Bates line thence a long said
line to the beginning containing fifty Acres more or less.
Together with all and singular the Right members
Appurtenances & appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining unto
the said Matthew Carter & his heirs for ever & I do hereby
bind my self my heirs Executors &c. to warrant & for-
ever defend the above described Premises unto the said
Carter against my self & my heirs & against every other
person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof in witness whereof I have set my hand
and affixed my seal this 6 day of January 1818 signed
sealed and delivered in presence of
