E. 6. 50 to a post oak corner thence N. 21 W. 34. 25 to a post oak near a dead Post oak Goodjoins Corner thence N. 55. W. 5. 40 to a blunet a corner between William Butler and John Mason thence S. 55. W. 23. to a red oak by a road thence S. 24 W. 20 to the beginning supposing to contain eighty four acres be the same more or less it being part of a survey of Land originally granted to Robert Goodjohn together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident to have and to hold all and singular the Rights and appurtenances unto her the said Eliza Hannah her heirs Executors administrators for ever and I do hereby warrant and forever defend the same or my part thereof from my self my heirs executors administrators or from any other person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 23<sup>d</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty two and in the forty fifth year of Americas independence Signed Sealed & acknowledged the day and year above written in the presence of Reuben B.
