

 my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all
 all and singular the said premises unto the said William Dancy his heirs
 and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other per-
 son or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
 any part thereof; witness my hand and seal this seventh day of October
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two.
