State of South Carolina Greenville District: Know all men by these presents that I John Green of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to me paid by Thomas P. Hudson of the district and State aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas P. Hudson all that tract or parcel of Land containing five acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on Pines Creek and a branch thereof waters of Snow River the same being part of a tract originally granted to Margret Cooke bearing date the twenty first day of January A.D. 1785. beginning on a Post oak corner 3x old corner of a tract granted to George Hite thence N 69. W 60 links to a white oak corner 3x on the upper bank of a Spring thence through the middle of said Spring and down the branch running the meanders to Pines Creek to a white oak 3x thence down the said creek running the meanders to an ash 3x on the north of said creek thence S 53. E. to a hickory corner 3x on the old original line thence a straight line to the beginning together with all and singular the Rights minus hindertments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas P. Hudson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the Rights and titles of the said premises unto the said Thomas
