


State of South Carolina Spartanburg District

Know all men by presents that I John Peace of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid to me in hand by Joseph Embury of the district aforesaid the said John Peace have granted bargained and sold unto the said Joseph Embury a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the district of Greenville District on the waters of Nanny Creek waters of N. Pacolet including both sides of Nanny's Creek bounded on all sides believed to be Vacant Land having such shape and form and marker as the annexed represent being on a ridge called the Grind Stone Quarry on a post oak thence N. 40. E. 17. to a Post oak thence N. 20. W. 19. to a pine N. 85. W. 12. to a pine thence N. 70. W. 24. Chs. to a chestnut thence 61. W. 41. Chs. to a red oak 5.9 Chs. to a saw wood thence N. 83. E. 15. to a Hickory thence N. to a chestnut thence N. 61. E. 13. to a chestnut thence S. 56. E. 19 to the beginning Grind Stone Quarry being by estimation one hundred and thirty four acres be the same more or less being granted to John Black by his Excellency Joseph M. Pickens on the 5th day of December 1814. Together with all and singular the rights to the hereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same To have and to hold the same free and clear all incumbrance from me the said J. Peace my heirs and from any Person or any person claiming any part or Parcel of the same lawfully In witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen signed sealed and acknowledged in presence of us.
