-said have granted bargained sold, and released, and by these  
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Charity  
Martin all that plantation or tract of Land containing two  
hundred acres more or less, situate in the District aforesaid  
lying on the branches of Rudy River Beginning on a red oak 3x  
thence S. 14 W. 16. to a Stake thence S. 75 W. 13. to a hickory 3x thence S 30.  
E. 6. 25 to a Stake 3x. thence S 60 W. 1. 30 to a hickory 3x. all bounding on  
Joseph McCullough, line thence S. 20 E. 13. 50. to a Red oak 3x. near  
the head of a branch bounding on the heirs of John Thumason de-  
-ceased thence down the meander of said branch a bout <sup>Ch. Link</sup> 64. 50 to  
an ash 3x. thence N. 14. E to a Stake on a branch thence up the meander  
of said branch bounding on James Bowen to the beginning Together  
with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurten-  
ances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or apper-  
taining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said Charity Martin her heirs and assigns forever  
And I do here by bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators  
to warrant and forever defend. all and singular the said premises unto  
the said Charity Martin her heirs and assigns against myself and  
my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claim-  
ing or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand  
and seal this fourth day of April in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and twenty three and in the for-  
-ty seventh year of the Independence of the United States of America
