Know all men by these presents that I William
Edwards of Grunville Dist. & State aforesaid, for and in consid-
eration of two hundred dollars to me paid by Gilman
Miller of the said State & Dist have granted, bargained
sold, & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell
and release unto the R. Gilman Miller all that tract or
parcel of land situate lying and being in the dist-
& State aforesaid on the south side of the Canbricke bra-
nch of Enoe River being part of two tracts originally
granted to Uriah Conner & one Kemp containing by esti-
mation two hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less the
said land being conveyed from the said Conner & Kemp th-
rough Varians hand to Thomas Edwards and being sold
by the Sheriff of Grunville District to satisfy a judgment
against the said Thomas Edwards & purchased by the
above named William Edwards. Binding on land
of John Green, Henry James, Jesse Hawkins and
Others. Together with all and singular the Rights
members hereditaments and appertaining thereto
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto
and to hold all and singular the above described premises unto the
said Gilman Miller his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind
myself heirs Exec^t & adm^r to warrant & forever defend the Rights
of the said premises unto the said Miller his heirs and assigns again
st my self my heirs Exec^t & adm^r & against every other person or persons
lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof witness my
hand and seal this 5 day of August A.D. one thousand
eight hundred and twenty three and in the forty
eighth Year of American Independence
