

for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Joshua Johnson of the district and State aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Joshua Johnson a plantation or tract of land lying and being situate in the district and State aforesaid on the waters of Gilders Creek it being originally granted to Joseph Reed and conveyed through different hands down to the said Wilson. the land to be conveyed begins on Box Sheltons Corner then on a conditional line on said Sheltons to State 3x then So. 10 W. to Seabornes line to a conditional line bounded by Horatia Griffins to State 3x N. 10. E to the beginning including one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises afove mentioned unto the said Joshua Johnson and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the Premises afove mentioned unto the said Joshua Johnson his heirs and assigns forever; against my self and any heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal this 10th day of October 1815 signed and acknowledged before us.
