 Corner on the bank of the River thence on Danchoor land thence
 on Nicholds land to a red oak thence on John Bayles line to a stake
 corner on Shattens line thence a long a long the said line to Young
 Pooles line thence a long the said line to the River thence down
 the meanders of the River to the begining all together containing
 three hundred and twenty Acres being the same tract which was
 conveyed by Young Griffin to Frederick Little by deed bearing date
 the 24th day of February A.D. 1817. and Recorded in B. K. June the 5th A.D.
 1817 One third part of the tract a bove described and mentioned is here
 -by inteded to be conveyed being the distributive Share of Peter
 Stanfield in the said tract in right of his wife And Whereas
