 my daughter Margaret Cannel wife of William Cannel of

 sideration of One dollar to me paid by the said Margaret
 Cannel have given granted bargained & delivered and by
 these presents do give grant bargain and deliver unto the
 said Margaret Cannel and to the heirs of her body two certai
 n negro girls named Dasha & Hannah (one six years
 and the other four years old) with their future incre-
 ase unto the said Margaret Cannel and the heirs of her
 body henceforth forever to be divided by sale or otherwise at
 the death of her present husband William Cannel equally betw
 en her and her said heirs and in case she should die first
 then to be divided as aforesaid among her said heirs hereby
 warranting and defending the said negro girls and their future
 increase unto the said Margaret Cannel her heirs as aforesaid
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 18 day of October 1823.
