 to and subscribed before me this 30 January 1824.

This indenture made this twenty fifth day of October in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight & three between Reuben Red-
 -man of South Carolina & district of Greenville of the one part
 & Robert Redman of the same State and place of the other part
 witnesseth that the said Reuben Redman for and in consid-
 -eration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand
 paid by the said Robert Redman the Receipt where of
 is here by acknowledged he the said Reuben Redman
 hath bargained & sold and by these presents doth bargain
 & sell unto the said Robert Redman a certain tract or
 piece of land containing by estimation fifty acres lying
 & being in Greenville District beginning at a post Oak corner
 Original he coming to Pauls Honor from thence a long said
 line to begin by the beginning at William Redman corner thence
 down down said branch as meanders to brushy creek thence
 down to bank as meanders to the maple stone which is tract
 of land of fifty acres be the same more or less with all
 & every of its appertinances the said Reuben Redman doth
 give himself & his heirs & from all and every person & persons
