 A. W. Crowder Sheriff of Greenville District - District and State
 aforesaid. Send greeting. Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias is
 sued out of the court of common pleas held for the District of Greenville to the
 second day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight
 hundred and twenty one at the suit of The Treasurer of the state of
 South Carolina against Adam Garrett to me directed commanding
 me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of Adam Garret-
