South Carolina, this indenture, made the thirteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four between Henry M. Tarrant of Greenville District and the State aforesaid of the one part and Edmund Waddill of the same Place, of the other part, witnesseth, that as the said Henry Tarrant and Carter Tarrant stands indebted to the said Edmund Waddill by of hand bearing everlastingly with in the full sum of Two thousand seven hundred and ninety three dollars and fourteen cents Now this indenture witnesseth, that the said Henry Tarrant for and in consideration of the said debt or sum payable as aforesaid to the said Edmund Waddill and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Edmund Waddill according to the nature aforesaid, and also in consideration of one dollar by him the said Edmund Waddill in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of of these presents, do grant bargain sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said Edmund Waddill and to his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or plantation of land lying in the district and State aforesaid on the Golden Grove Creek beginning on the said Creek at an ash running thence S. 64° E 2. 78 chains to a maple thence N. 75° E 22 chains to a maple thence S. 64° E 11.5 chains to a black oak thence N. 62° E 110.8 chains to a dogwood, thence N. 80° E 24. 75 chains to porimine, thence S. 49° E 6.67.
