ing or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and Seal this fourteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four and in the forty seventh year of American Independance Signed sealed &

State of South Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that I Thos Kintchen Carr, of the State aforesaid And District of Pendleton for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Kelly I have granted Bargained sold and delivered unto John Kelly A tract of Land suppose to contain one hundred and fifty acres more or less it being part of a tract of land granted to Elias Earles, and by him conveyed to Robert Earles and by him to Kintchen Carr being situated on the south side of Saluda River Beginning on the River on Plesha land beyond Carr thence along the conditional line to a red oak to the head of a hollow thence along the Spring Branch to the River thence along the meanders of the River to the Beginning corner which includes the whole together with all land
