D. 3^x thence South 30th N. 44th to Pine 3^x thence S 64th E. 36th to Hickory 3^x thence N. 31th E. 43. 50 to

B. Gum 3^x on creek thence along the meanders of said Creek to the beginning Together with all and singular the Right members hereditaments and appertinances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said H. Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said H.
