


At a Red Oak 3⁴ thence N. 8 M. 76. to a state + 3. thence

 Down the River a cross the aforesaid Branch to the

 go along a conditional line to the Beginning Red
 Oak. Together with all and singular, the Rights mem-
 bers Hereditaments and appertinances, thereunto-
 belonging or in any wise incident there unto to the
 said Murray Woodson his heirs and assigns To have and
 To hold all and singular the said premises and so
 Hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and adm-
 inistrators to warrant and forever defend, all and
 singular the said premises unto the said Murray
 Woodson his heirs or assigns against myself my
 heirs or assigns and against every other person or
 Persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof In witness whereof I have here
 unto set my hand and affixed my seal this first
 Day of may one thousand Eight hundred and
 Twenty four and of the Independence of the Un-
 ited States of America forty Eight, signed sealed
 and delivered in presence of ² Ezekiel Vinson, ² Jacob Roberts, ² Tucker Woodson
