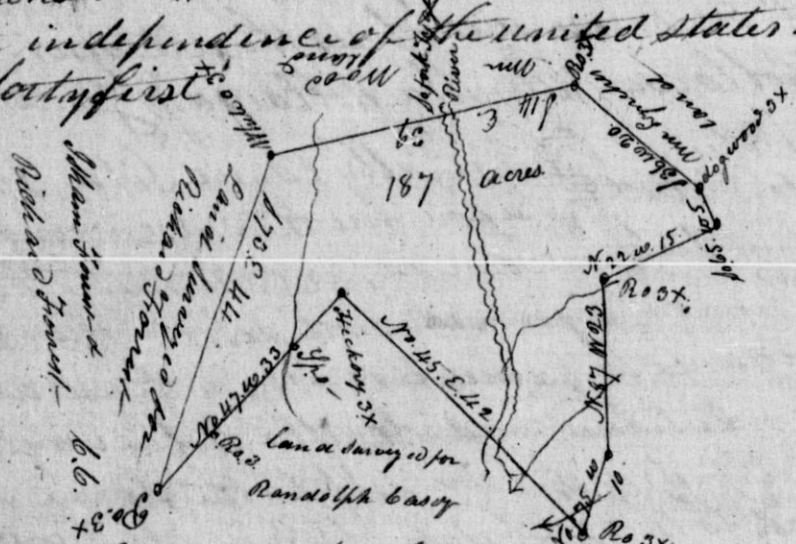


Granted: "passed the 19th day of February, 1791: we
 Have granted; and by these presents do grant unto John
 Forest his heirs and assigns, a plantation or tract of land
 containing one hundred & Eighty seven acres, surveyed
 for him the 19th of Nov: 1813 Situate in Greenville District
 on both Sides of South Tyger River, A. Pickens Junr. -
 having such Shape, Form and marks, as are represented
 By a plat hereunto annexed Together with all woods,
 Land, waters, water courses: profits, commodities, appur
 tenance and hereditaments what soever. them unto bel
 onging: To have and to hold the said tract of one hundred
 and Eighty seven acres of land, and all and singular,
 other the premises hereby granted unto the said John
 Forest his heirs and assigns for ever, in fee and
 Common Soeage. Given under the seal of the State
 Witness his Excellency, Andrew Pickens Junr. Esqur.
 Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the
 said State at Columbia this third day of March
 Anno domini one thousand Eight hundred and fourteen
 and of the independence of the united States of amer
 -ica, the forty first
