Present<sup>s</sup> that I Jesse Ford of the State and district aforesaid,  
in consideration of two hundred and fifty dollars,  
To me paid by Phillip Miller, of the State and District  
Aforesaid hath Granted Bargained Sold and Released  
and by these present<sup>s</sup> do Grant Bargain sell & Release  
unto D<sup>r</sup> Phillip Miller a plantation and part of three  
Tracts of land one originally granted to Steven Ford  
For 200 acres, the other granted to Drury Smith for  
100 acres the third, Granted to D<sup>r</sup> Jesse Ford for 55 acres  
on the first day of December 1794 the two former  
Conveyed Bound to D<sup>r</sup> Ford now from D<sup>r</sup> Ford to D<sup>r</sup> -  
Miller part of the two former and the hole, of such tract  
Supposed to be two hundred and fifty acres, includ-  
ing the plantation where D<sup>r</sup> Ford now lives situate  
in the State and District aforesaid, on the S. side of  
The Rudy Fork of Rudy River Begining on the  
Bank of D<sup>r</sup> Rudy Fork Bounded on the N. E. by Elham  
Burns on S. W. and S. by Sard Burns, and Thos. Rice to a  
Post oak a corner of the 55. acre tract thence on the  
original line of D<sup>r</sup>. tract S. 37. E. 13. 5d. to a Post oak thence  
S. 70. E. 23. 10 to a Post oak, then N. 24. E to the Rudy fork  
Then up S. Fork until meanders to the Beginning together  
with all and singular the Rights members hereditam-  
ents and appurtenances to the premises belonging or in  
anywise incident or appertaining to have and to  
Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the S<sup>r</sup> Phillip Miller his heirs and assigns --
