ke corner, from thence N. 47. E. 22. 66 to the begining
Post oak corner, Together, with all and singular the
Rights, members, heriditaments, and appertanances
To the said premises belonging or in any wise in-
cident or appertaining to have and to hold all and
Singular the premises befoe mentioned unto
The said Jesse Shockley his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind my self my heirs, Exors, and
Admors, to warrant and forever defend all and
Singular the said premises unto the said Jesse Shockley
his heirs and assigns, against my self and my heirs
