Parcel or tract of land lying and being in Greenville District  
& State aforesaid near the village of Greenville on the  
Augusta Road leading from the said village of Greenville  
To Augusta Georgia and adjoining the land whereon I no-  
w live that is to say Beginning on a Stake on the Road thence  
S. 80. W. 11 chrs. 78 lk. to a Post oak 3x thence N. 38. E. 4. 88. to a Red oak  
3x thence N. 72. W. 4. 88 to a Pine Stump 3x. thence N. 10. E. 15. 50.  
to a Red oak bush 3x thence N. 60. E. 4. 60. to a Stake on the  
Road thence along said Road to the Beginning Stake corner  
Agreeable to a plat made by George Seaborn herunto-  
-joined containing by estimation eighteen acres the same  
More or less together with all and singular the Rights  
Members, hereditaments and appertanencies to the said pur-
