attorney for me and in my name and stead to
ask and demand of the Secretary of the State of
North Carolina or of the Military Land Commis-
sioner of the University of the State of North Carolina a
Military Land Warrant for my right and to give such
receipts as may be lawful and proper for the
discharging of my claim to the same and in my
name and stead make over or signment on said
Warrant or if said warrant be located and laid

I hereby Authorise my said attorney to make a
transfer on the same to whom he may think proper
and to do all acts and things for the recovery of
said land warrant sell and transfer the same
in as full and ample a manner as I myself could do
were I personally present to appoint one or more attorneys
under him vesting him with the same power as himself
then power at pleasure to revoke hereby ratifying and confirm-
ing all and every thing my said attorney or his substitute
attorneys shall or may Lawfully do in and about the
said premises in Testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this Ninth day
of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight
Hundred and twenty five In the presence
