Jeremiah Cleveland, his heirs, & against myself, my heirs and against every other Person Lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof in w^hitsoever where of, I have here unto set my hand and seal this the 18. day of January 1825 Signed sealed & delivered in presence -
