 presents that I George Michil, of the District of Green
 ville and state aforesaid, for and in consideration of the
 sum of four hundred dollars to me paid by Thomas=
 Barton of the state and district aforesaid, have granted,
 bargained sold and released and by these presents do,
 Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas=
 Barton all that tract or parcel of land situate in the
 District, of Greenville and state aforesaid, on the head of
 the sink hole fork of Tiger River, beginning, at a chesnut
 A near Edmond Berdins, white oak corner, and running
 thence north eighty chain to a chesnut thence west to
 the head of a Branch west of where Thomas Bowers, now
 lives running thence south with said branch to Michael
 Shewits, line thence east and to follow said line with
 its different courses untill it intersects, with Richard=
 Wards line thence on Wards, line to the river thence
 Down the river to the mouth of a branch thence due
 South untill it crosses the original line on Tittus=
 mountain thence east to the beginning corner,
 containing by estimation four hundred acres, be the
 same more or less the same being part of a tract
