acres of land be the same more or less for and in con-
-sideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty
dollars paid by the said William Green the receipt of
-which is hereby acknowledged together with all and singular
the rights members and appurtenances thereunto be-
-longing or in any wise appertaining to the same to
have and to hold the said plantation or tract
of land if being part of a tract originally gran-
-ted to George Lewis and by said conveyed to Aaron
Kemp from J. Kemp to Edward Allen and from
-said Allen to William Green lying and being on Bras
-h Creek on the upper end of ~~the~~ original tract
beginning at a pine knot corner & runs N. 52. W 27 ch to
a Red Oak corner thence S. 10. W. 12 ch to a poplar
corner thence S. 62. W 27 ch to a black Jack corner
thence S 24 E 60 ch to a stake or Alstons line thence a
long Alstons line to the upper end of said original
tract thence to the beginning together with all the rights
members and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
any wise thereunto belonging to him the said William
Green his heirs and assigns for ever and I the said
Edward Allen do hereby forever warrant and
defend the same from myself my heirs and from
every other person or persons who are ^{lawfully} claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
