Lemont Hatcher in the district and state aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said F. Lemont Hatcher a plantation and tract of land lying in the State and district aforesaid on the North side of Ruckey River on Branches of S. River beginning on a stake on the branch thence East 41.50 to a black oak 3x bound on Baker's land thence North 8.20 to a stake thence N. 60. W. 20 to a stake on Red Oak 3x bounded by Robert Pedens land thence continuing the same line N. 60 W. 78. to a red Oak 3x bounded by Map. John Alexanders land thence S. 26. W. 5.50 to a red oak 3x thence S. 70. E. 9 to a stake thence N. 69. E. 12.26 to a poplar on the Branch thence along the meanders of S. branch bounded by John Harris's land to the beginning including the plantation where the said Maffey now lives with one hundred and ninety seven acres of land be the same more or less Together with all and singular the Rights members here appurtenances and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenancing to have and to hold all and singular the premises here mentioned unto the said F. Lemont Hatcher his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant aid for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said F. Lemont Hatcher his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and Seal this 5 day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand and eighteen and in the forty second year of the Independence of the United States of America signed sealed and acknowledged and delivered in presence of
